INFORMATION SHEET

The Staff of Camp CJ invites all youth, from entering 5th grade through existing seniors to join in a week of fun and fellowship. The week's activities include sports, campfires, crafts and more. Each day begins with preaching, lots of singing, and continues with Discipleship Classes and Vespers. The week is filled with friendly competition between color groups. The week's highlights can include a concert, Communion service and a dance on the last night. It is a fun filled week in which new friendships are made that last long after the week is over and we hope that you will join us!

Cost of camp will be \$135 per camper. (*Make checks payable to District Camp/Camp CJ*) Send completed application and payment to Camp CJ c/o Pastor David A. Peters, 1677 Lens Creek Road, Marmet, WV 25315.

You may register anytime for camp, however the earlier we receive your application the better. This ensures that the campers get their correct t-shirt size and in the cabins of choice, it also allows for the camp facility to order the correct amount of food needed for the week. We will accept walk-in registrations the morning of camp but this makes things a little rougher on our staff and the Camp Summer staff.

Camp CJ 2018, June 25-29, 2018 Arrival and Dismissal Times: Campers should plan to arrive between 9:30 and 11:00 AM on Monday, June 25th. Campers will be released at 12 noon on Friday, June 29th after our final assembly. Please be on time to pick up campers and feel free to join us for our final assembly.

Camp Discipline: The Camp Staff reserves the right to maintain discipline within the camp. This may include time-out, assignment of different duties, or return a camper home for flagrant infraction of camp rules. (Camp rules are discussed at our opening assembly on Monday) Returning a camper home will be done only in consultation with parent or guardian listed on application. If camper is returned home there will be no refund.

What to Bring: Hot weather clothes (please dress appropriately. Inappropriate dress may be asked to change.), swimming attire (please be modest), comfortable walking shoes, you may want to include long pants and sweat shirts -in praying that the nights may be cool. 1 set of dress clothes for Thursday night Communion Service and Dinner, your Bible, pencil/pens and a notebook. Towels, wash cloths, soap and personal hygiene products (Soap, shampoo, toothbrush & toothpaste, deodorant, etc). Sleeping bag or twin sheets, and pillows for your bed. Small fan, flashlight and extra batteries. Sports equipment if taking sports.

What not to Bring: Tobacco product*, alcohol*, fireworks*, firearms*, knives*, cell phones, skating equipment, anything you would be upset if it got lost or stolen. There is no cell service, and there are not times to play electronic games, etc. *if these items are found they will be confiscated and may result in disciplinary actions.

Camp Store: The camp will have snacks and pop, etc. to sell. Campers will be allowed to visit the store during times approved by camp staff. Camp CJ will offer a Camp Bank in which each camper can leave their money safely with camp staff and can be accessed during camp store hours. We suggest small bills for convenience. Money can be put in bank upon arrival Monday and is the camper's responsibility to pick up balance before leaving on Friday. All monies not deposited in the camp bank will be the responsibility of the camper.

Leaving Camp Early: Sometimes it becomes necessary for campers to return home early for personal reasons. Make these arrangements in advance and in consultation with Camp Director. Camp Director will decide if refund is permitted.

From Beckley

1-64 to Sandstone/Hinton exit turn Left follow Rt. 20 to Hinton, at stop light take a right across bridge, turn left off bridge. Approximately 2 miles, come to an intersection (Kirks Restaurant) turn left across bridge. At end of bridge, veer right, follow Rt. 3 south. Drive 5.2 miles; go straight through Rt. 3/Rt. 12 intersections. Follow Rt. 12 south toward Forest Hill/Peterstown. 4 miles to 4-H Camp Rd. and turn left. Camp gate is .7 miles on left.

From Lewisburg

South on Rt. 12/Rt. 3 toward Talcott, cross blue bridge and turn left onto Rt. 12 south toward Forest Hill/Peterstown, 4 miles to 4-H Camp Road and turn left. Camp gate is .7 miles on left.

From Union

Follow Greenville Road toward Hinton. Turn right onto Rt. 12 toward Forest Hill. You will see 4-H Camp Road on your right. Camp Gate is .7 miles on left.

From Princeton

Leaving Princeton, go Rt. 20 North towards Athens/Hinton. After passing the Bluestone Dam, turn right onto bridge. At end of bridge, veer right on Rt. 3 south. Drive 5.2 miles; go straight through Rt. 3/Rt. 12 intersections. Follow Rt. 12 south toward Forest Hill/Peterstown. 4 miles to 4-H Camp Road and turn left. Camp gate is .7 miles on left.
